## SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO.88 FY10

**SUBJECT:** **English Language Learner (ELL) Reserve**

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The goal of the Chancellor's *Children First* initiative is to ensure that all students have access to a high-quality education and graduate high school prepared for college, careers, and citizenship. Many students who are not native English speakers will need additional support to achieve at high levels. This allocation is intended to allow schools to provide supplemental services to English Language Learners (ELLs) who were either not funded via the 2009-10 Fair Student Funding ELL allocations and/or who enrolled at the school after October 31, 2009.

All other schools that have had increases in enrollment of 30 or more ELLs are funded on a per capita basis of \$1107 for each additional ELL. 2009-10 ELL enrollments per school were calculated based on BESIS data as of January 22, 2010.

For all other schools with increases in ELL enrollment of 30 or more:

- The allocation was based on the difference between the number of ELLs funded in the 2009-10 FSF and 2009-10 ELL enrollment.
- For schools that did not receive funding for ELL students prior to this allocation, additional ELL students were based on a per capita basis \$1107.

A list of funded schools is attached, along with numbers of additional ELL students by grade span. All allocations will be made through the following allocation category: **TL FSF ELL Reserve and TL FSF ELL Reserve HS**
