SUBJECT: **PSYCHOLOGIST-IN-TRAINING (PIT) ALLOCATION**

The Psychologist-In-Training (PIT) program is a recruitment program focusing on bilingual school psychologists. The program offers a one-year salaried internship. In September, the interns attend a month-long professional development program. For the remaining months (October through June), interns receive school-based mentoring from a school psychologist. Upon completion of the program, interns agree to work in the city school system for a minimum of one year. There are 22 interns participating in the PIT Program in the 2010-2011 school year.

Allocations will be provided via the transfer utility function in Galaxy. Allotments are based on a citywide average PIT salary of \$43,213. For FY11, allocations will be provided to the schools for the entire school year, rather than prorated for nine months as was the case in previous years. Funds should be scheduled in the allocation category **TL SBST SHARED**.
