SUBJECT: **ATTENDANCE IMPROVEMENT/DROPOUT PREVENTION (AIDP) DISCRETIONARY ALLOCATIONS**

The Attendance Improvement Dropout Prevention (AIDP) Discretionary allocation funds three services:

- Attendance support positions in eligible schools: allocations provide resources for school staff, such as family assistants, guidance counselors and other positions responsible for supporting attendance programs.
- Support for pilot schools in the Mayor's Initiative on Chronic Absenteeism: funds to cover extended use fees for Parent Summits, postage and mailings for initiative outreach and other related costs.
- Travel expenses for attendance teachers: an allocation of \$800 per position will be placed in payroll school Children First Networks (CFN).

Please note that funds that had been allocated to schools that were closed as of this year and funds that had been utilized last year for OTPS and per-session activities were re-distributed among AIDP eligible schools to cover staff positions.

The allocations are displayed on the attached table.

Schools selected to receive discretionary funding will be required to record all AIDP funded attendance support and counseling services into the ATS AIDP screens. Interventions may also be recorded in the ILOG System in ATS. This data will be monitored to ensure that the schools are providing AIDP funded services.

AIDP funding for attendance teacher positions is provided through allocations disseminated in School Allocation Memorandum (SAM) No. 55: [AIDP Attendance Teacher](#).

Programmatic information provided by the Office of School and Youth development.

School allocations are detailed in Table 1, the allocations for the Mayor's Truancy Initiative is detailed in Table 2 and the travel funding per CFN is shown on Table 3.
