SUBJECT: **LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT (LEP) AND IMMIGRANT TITLE III PROGRAMS**

This memorandum accompanies resources to support the Federal No Child Left Behind Act, Title III initiative for FY11. The initiative provides \$26.7M for supplemental services and may not be used to provide mandated bilingual and/or ESL services for English Language Learners (ELLs).

The Office of English Language Learners (ELLs) has established the following Title III guidelines: Title III supplemental services for ELLs must include **direct instruction and high quality professional development** that is “of sufficient intensity and duration to have a positive and lasting impact on the teachers’ performance in classrooms.” Professional development activities should be well-planned, ongoing events rather than one-day or short-term workshops and conferences. Activities must be used to support language development, English and native language instruction, high academic achievement in Math, and/or other core academic areas. In addition, parent engagement activities are required. Parent engagement activities and supports must ensure that there are appropriate translation and interpretation services to meet community needs.

The Title III supplemental instructional services must be based on student need. These supplemental services should complement core bilingual and ESL services required under CR Part 154. Direct supplemental services should be provided for before school, after school, and Saturday programs as well as reduced class-size, and/or push-in services. Teachers providing the services must be certified bilingual education and/or ESL teachers.

Priority areas for the use of Title III funds are:

- Developing new and/or enhancing programs for newcomers,
- Developing new and/or enhancing Transitional Bilingual Education programs,
- Developing new and/or enhancing Dual Language programs,
- Developing new and/or enhancing programs for Students with Interrupted Formal Education (SIFE) and Long-Term ELLs,
- Improving teaching and learning in core subject areas,
- Improving native language and English teaching and learning,
- Enriching parent engagement activities and securing appropriate translation and interpretation services,
- Providing students with supplemental guidance,
- Implementing strong student supports to increase graduation rates, and
- Integrating ELLs in secondary school reforms.

Please be advised that schools receiving Title III funds should refer to their FY10 approved Title III application which includes a school plan and a budget narrative describing the use of these monies. Note: Title III funds may not be used to purchase core (i.e., basic) textbooks, materials, or supplies for mandated services. All Title III materials and services must be directly related to activities funded by Title III and kept to a minimum. All Title III funds must be accounted for in the budget narratives which must be aligned to the Title III plan.

Schoolwide Program (SWP) schools that are "conceptually" consolidating their federal, state, and FSF/tax levy funds, as described in their school's 2010-2011 CEP, are not required to develop and submit a separate Title III budget. However, SWP schools must ensure that the intent and purposes of the Title III funding are met, and must include in the CEP (in Appendix 2 and/or the action plans) a description of the strategies/activities the school will implement to meet the needs of English language learners.

For more information about development of the Title III school plan and budget narrative, please contact your ELL Compliance and Performance Specialist, or the ELL point person for your school's network. The submission of an approvable Title III application is necessary to ensure continued Title III funding. ELL Compliance and Performance Specialists review plans upon submission to ensure that they are state-approvable.

Schools allocations are based on the following:

- Schools with 0-29 ELLs in FY10 received \$0.
- Schools with 30-98 ELLs in FY10 received \$15,000.
- Schools with more than 98 ELLs in FY10 received \$140 per student beyond the \$15,000 base allocation.

Programmatic information and data provided by Division for Students with Disabilities and English Language Learners

All schools with 30 or more ELLs received Title III LEP funds; schools in districts 1, 2, 7, 9, 20, and 25, also received Title III Immigrant funds. Title III allocations should be scheduled in the allocation category, "**Title III LEP**", "**Title III LEP CW**" or "**Title III Immigrant.**" Scheduled funds must be reviewed and approved by the CFN Grants Liaison for fiscal compliance with Title III guidelines.
