SUBJECT: **GIFTED AND TALENTED SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION**

In an effort to sustain Gifted and Talented (G&T) programs – and to ensure that the DOE meets its commitment to offering a seat to every qualifying kindergarten and first grade student - the Department of Education (DOE) is providing supplemental amount of funding for each school with enrollment lower than 18 students in G&T classes that start in September 2010 (grades kindergarten thru first) or had started in September 2009 (grades first and second). The exact amount of funding is the school's average teacher salary with coverage minus the amount of that salary already covered via Fair Student Funding for the number of students enrolled.
