SUBJECT: **English Language Learner (ELL) Reserve**

The goal of the Chancellor's *Children First* initiative is to ensure that all students have access to a high-quality education and graduate high school prepared for college, careers, and citizenship. Many students who are not native English speakers will need additional support to achieve at high levels. This allocation is intended to allow schools to provide supplemental services to English Language Learners (ELLs) who were either not funded via the 2010-11 Fair Student Funding ELL allocations and/or who enrolled at the school after October 31, 2010.

Schools that have had increases of 30 or more ELLs are funded on a per capita basis of \$1,616 for each additional ELL. 2010-11 ELL enrollment per school were calculated based on BESIS data as of January 22, 2011.

- For schools that did not receive funding for ELL students prior to this allocation, additional ELL students were funded based on a per capita basis of \$1,616.

For New Small Schools which opened in 2009 and 2010 with a positive variance in the number of ELLs

- The allocation was based on the difference between the number of ELLs funded in the 2010-11 FSF formula and 2010-11 ELL enrollment.
- For small new schools that had a variance smaller than 15 the base allocation was set to \$10,000.
- For schools that did not receive funding for ELL students prior to this allocation, additional ELL students were funded based on a per capita basis of \$1,616.
