**SUBJECT:** January 2013 Regents Distributed Scoring

---

Regent's exams have historically been scored by students' own teachers or others at the school that they attend. In accordance with New York State Education Department policy that no longer allows teachers to score their own students exams, the New York City Department of Education is expanding the distributed scoring policy: teachers can no longer score Regents exams of students that attend their school.

In January 2013, all schools that administer Regents exams in grades 9-12 will participate in a citywide distributed scoring model for all exams, including those in alternate languages. The scoring of seven exams (Algebra 2/Trigonometry, Geometry, Global History & Geography, Physical Setting/Chemistry, Physical Setting/Earth Science, Physical Setting/Physics, and U.S. History and Government) will be performed at centrally-administered scoring sites after school and on the weekend of January 26-27. The scoring of three exams (Comprehensive English, Integrated Algebra and Living Environment) will be performed at scoring sites during the school day.

This allocation will help the 38 schools selected as scoring sites prepare for scoring of Regents exams. Schools serving as evening/weekend sites are allocated \$1,000. Schools serving as day scoring sites are allocated \$2,000. Schools may receive one or both allocations. Host school's Principals may use these funds for (1) Per Session for school staff including but not limited to teachers, school aides, computer technicians, guidance counselors, and supervisors, and/or (2) supplies. The allocations in Table 1 below will be placed in the allocation category **TL Regents Distributed Scoring**.

Scoring site schools will be expected to provide a detailed account of the use of these funds upon request.
