**SUBJECT:** January 2014 Regents Distributed Scoring

---

In accordance with NYSED policy, the NYC DOE will continue to utilize a distributed scoring policy in which teachers cannot score Regents exams of students that attend their school. This policy currently applies to all schools that administer Regents exams in grades 9 -12.

Scoring of the January 2014 Regents exams will occur during the school day as well as through a centrally administered per session activity to take place after school between January 29 - 31 and the weekend of February 1- 2, 2014. Resources will be provided to 38 school locations that have volunteered to serve as a host site for distributed scoring of the January 2014 Regents exams.

This allocation is to support scoring of Regents exams at these citywide scoring sites. The allocation may be used to cover per session activities for staff at Regents distributed scoring sites to prepare for scoring, to purchase materials and supplies to support scoring, or for any other use determined by the host school's Principal. Participating schools will receive \$2,000 to host a day scoring site, and \$1,000 to host a per session site. Sites scheduled to score Algebra and/or U.S. History are allotted an extra \$125 which may be used for photocopier or printer supplies to print time sensitive scoring guides. The allotments in Table 1 below will be placed in **TL Regents Distributed Scoring**.

Scoring site schools will be expected to provide a detailed account of the use of these funds upon request.
