SUBJECT: June 2014 Regents Distributed Scoring

In accordance with NYSED policy, the NYC DOE will continue to utilize a distributed scoring policy in which teachers cannot score Regents exams of students that attend their school. This policy currently applies to all schools that administer all Regents exams in grades 9 -12 as well as middle schools that administer Regents exams to advanced students.

Scoring of the June 2014 Regents exams will occur in two parts – the Common Core exams in Algebra I and English Language Arts will be administered in early June, and the remaining exams aligned to the 2005 State standards will be administered in late June. Scoring for Common Core will take place in per session from June 4 – 8. Remaining Regents exams will be scored during the school day as well as through a centrally administered per session activity to take place after school between June 18 – 26. Resources will be provided to all 42 school locations that have volunteered to serve as a host site for distributed scoring of the June 2014 Regents exams.

This allocation is to support scoring of Regents exams at these citywide scoring sites. The allocation may be used to cover per session activities for staff at Regents distributed scoring sites to prepare for scoring.

Participating schools will receive funds according to the following schedule: \$2,000 for English Language Learner (ELL) schools to host a day scoring site; \$2,500 for sites scoring only Comprehensive English exams in per session; \$3,500 for schools who will score one or more Regents exam subjects during the day and in per session (excluding Common Core); \$4,000 for sites who will score both the English Language Arts (Common Core) and Comprehensive English Exams; and \$5,000 for sites that will score exams across multiple subjects.

The allotments in Table 1 below will be placed in the **TL Regents Distributed Scoring** allocation category.

Scoring site schools will be expected to provide a detailed account of the use of these funds upon request.
