SUBJECT: FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT COLLABORATION WITH SCHOOLS IN
THE NEW YORK PERFORMANCE STANDARDS CONSORTIUM

The Office of Academic Quality's Periodic Assessment (PA) Program is allocating funds to schools that are part of the New York Performance Standards Consortium (Consortium) in order to collaborate and learn about best practices for implementing performance-based assessments.

The 2013-14 Periodic Assessment expectations are for schools to demonstrate strong formative assessment practice. The Periodic Assessment Portfolio provides a variety of supports to help schools address their needs through the procurement of materials, coordination of data transfers, and/or professional development. The PA program also supports schools that are actively engaged in developing and formalizing school structures and assessments that meet Periodic Assessment expectations. Consortium schools collaborate to develop their own PA assessments. The Consortium also supports these schools with the development of high school curricula aligned to the Common Core. The DOE will collaborate with the Consortium throughout this fiscal year to learn about best practices in performance assessment design and curriculum development.

To support the development of school-based formative assessments and associated curricular work, 46 schools will receive \$3,500 each. Funds can be used by schools to (1) purchase and implement formative assessments as well as interpret and communicate results to families; (2) purchase texts, materials, and printing supplies (*i.e.*, paper and toner); and/or (3) per session payments to educators to attend professional development workshops offered through the Consortium.

Network CFN 102 is also receiving funds to support per session attendance at workshops across all Consortium schools.

The attached table displays the allocation for each school receiving funding for formative assessment and Common Core-aligned curricular work. Funds should be scheduled in the
