**SUBJECT:** Broadway Junior Arts Supplement

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This allocation provides supplemental per session funding to support first and second-year schools participating in the Shubert/MTI Broadway Junior Program. This program brings musical theater into middle schools that are currently underserved in the arts and provides the training and materials necessary for schools to create and present a production to their school communities in Spring 2015. The first-year schools included in this allocation were selected through an open application process, administered by Office of Arts and Special Projects in Fall 2014. The second-year schools were selected through an open application process in Fall 2013 and have committed to continuing their participation in the program through this school year.

This memorandum details the funding that selected schools will receive in FY 2015. Funding must be used to offset per session expenses for Broadway Junior program-related activities that occur during out-of-school time (i.e. rehearsals, teacher professional development workshops, production meetings, etc.) Schools are expected to cover all other associated production expenses and per session hours as outlined in the program application. Schools may not use funding to supplant previously allocated funds or as the sole funding source for this program.

Each of the 15 first-year participating schools will receive \$5,000 in funding. Each of the eight second-year participating schools will receive \$2,500 in funding. Funds are furnished to schools under the allocation categories **TL Broadway Junior Arts Supplement**, **TL Broadway Junior Arts Supplement HS**, and **TL Broadway Junior Arts Supplement CW**. These funds may only be used for per session expenses.

Please refer to Chancellor's Regulation 175 (C-175) for per session instructions, including the process for approval of per session hours, and necessary documentation for payment for per session activities. Documentation must include timecards, time sheets, job postings and applications for the posting.
