SUBJECT: Green Cup Energy Challenge Awards

The Division of School Facilities, in partnership with the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, is allocating funds in support of the winning participants in the NYC-Green Schools Alliance November 2014 Green Cup Energy Challenge. This program is designed to recognize schools that have successfully taken the Challenge by reducing their electricity consumption over a four week period.

All schools that reduced electric consumption received funds per kilowatt hour (kWh) reduced. At any given site, only the school that registered and was primarily responsible for managing and reporting on the challenge results will receive the school allocation.

Funds should be scheduled in **INTRACITY Revenue DCAS-DSF PLANYC Green Cup**, Quick Code 49841. The funds are unrestricted for OTPS purchases and should be used in accordance with Standard Operating Procedures. All funds must be used in FY 2015.
