The Golden Apple Awards are part of the NYC Department of Sanitation's education and awareness campaign in the schools. This program provides cash prizes to winning schools that conceive and complete exemplary applied-learning projects demonstrating awareness and civic responsibility in recycling, waste prevention and community beautification, with additional awards for model indoor or outdoor composting projects. Schools compete in three contests within their grade division and borough.

The program is fully funded by the NYC Department of Sanitation through an intra-city transfer to NYCDOE. There are no restrictions on the use of these funds, although the Department of Sanitation encourages schools to further enhance their school recycling programs, waste prevention initiatives and beautification projects. **All funds must be expended by June 30, 2015.**

Funding will be scheduled in the **Golden Apple Awards** allocation category. See Table 1 for award amounts.
