SUBJECT: Arts Continuum Program

This memorandum allocates supplemental funding to schools to support school-based arts projects and residencies that aim to bridge arts learning between the elementary and middle school grades. The schools included in this allocation were selected through the 2015-2016 *Arts Continuum* grant program, administered by the Office of Arts and Special Projects.

Funds allocated in this memorandum must be used to support the arts education projects/residencies described by schools in their *Arts Continuum* grant applications. Funding may be used to pay for direct services from arts and cultural organizations (e.g. school-based arts residences, performances, curriculum development and planning, and production of project-related reports). In addition, each school will receive a per session allocation to cover teacher hours for grant project-related activities including planning, meetings, and curriculum review.

Schools will be expected to cover all other associated project expenses (e.g. additional per session hours, supplies, materials, and project resources not provided by the arts education partners). Schools may not use funding to supplant previously allocated funds.

Individual school OTPS allocations range between \$2,640 and \$21,360, varying based on the amount schools had requested in their grant applications. The Per Session allocation for each school is \$1,058, to be used for up to 24 hours of teacher per session. Schools will receive *Arts Continuum* funding via two discrete allocation categories:

- **TL Arts Continuum Program OTPS** or **TL Arts Continuum Program OTPS HS** – Allocation category can only be used to support OTPS costs of direct student services.
- **TL Arts Continuum Program PS** or **TL Arts Continuum Program PS HS** – Allocation category can be only be scheduled for teacher per session in Galaxy.

All standard operating procedures and fiscal year deadlines for procurement with tax levy funds apply. Schools will be required to provide documentation of all expenditures made with this funding allocation as part of an end-of-year project/residency report that will be submitted to the Office of Arts and Special Projects. Timely submission of a complete report in June 2016 will influence decisions regarding future school allocations.
