SUBJECT: Students with Interrupted Formal Education (SIFE) and
Long-Term English Language Learners (LTE) Grant

This memorandum allocates funds to schools participating in the Students with Interrupted Formal Education (SIFE) and Long-Term ELL (LTE) Initiative. Each participating school was required to have its program proposal approved by the Department of English Language Learners and School Support.

The SIFE/LTE Initiative provides funding, technical assistance, professional development, and networking opportunities to participating schools so they can develop and implement new ways to serve these two ELL subgroups. Based on 2013-2014 SY data, one out of every ten ELLs has been identified as a SIFE at some point during their time in the New York City public school system. ELLs who have received service for more than six years, known as long-term ELLs, make up 12.9% of the system's overall ELL population. The SIFE/LTE Initiative allows schools to better serve these high-needs populations by offering specialized learning opportunities to support SIFE and LTEs in building academic language and literacy. At the same time, it focuses on the socio-emotional support these students require to be successful in school. The SIFE/LTE Initiative gives schools the flexibility to structure a student program, professional development, and parent engagement activities that are tailored to the needs of each school and its students.

Participating schools create learning communities based on the model they choose to implement, as stated in their proposals. Schools send appropriate staff members for professional development as directed. All sites are required to maintain appropriate documentation of grant activities and evaluate program implementation, materials, and overall effectiveness. Additionally, all schools are required to send an administrator and at least one teacher to a culminating grant activity, to be held in the spring, where schools will share the grant activities that were most effective in meeting the needs of SIFE, LTEs, their parents, and the educators who work with them.

This funding will be distributed in rounds. This is the initial set of schools to receive funding during this fiscal year.

Allocations will be placed in each school's budget in allocation category **TL SIFE ELL** or **TL SIFE ELL HS**.
