SUBJECT: Title III - Supplemental Bilingual Program Home Language Arts (HLA)
Classroom Libraries Initiative

This memorandum provides resources to Transitional Bilingual Education (TBE) and Dual Language (DL) programs in participating schools through the Title III Supplemental Bilingual Program Home Language Arts Classroom Libraries Initiative.

The Title III Supplemental Bilingual Program HLA Classroom Libraries Initiative provides funding for schools that have been either identified as having a model TBE and/or DL program during 2015-16 school year or have an existing TBE and/or DL program that was opened during the last three years and will continue to grow or strengthen these programs during the 2016-2017 school year.

Transitional Bilingual Education programs in New York City allow ELLs to receive instruction in the students' native language and English in different percentages according to the student's level of proficiency as students develop their English proficiency. The time allocated to native-language learning shifts to English language learning until the student reaches proficiency.

Dual Language programs are enrichment programs that allow English Language Learners (ELLs) of one common language and English proficient students to learn together in two languages-English and a target language. Students not only develop new language skills and learn academic subjects in two languages, but they also practice and share language and culture with each other, making them bilingual, bi-literate and bicultural.

Awarded schools are able to use the funds to purchase Home Language classroom libraries from the following approved vendors ([link with list of vendors](#)). Please consider using the NYC DOE literacy Instructional Material Review Rubric to ensure that the books are aligned to the CCLS. Schools must forward copies of each purchase order to Division of English Language Learners and Student Support (DELLSS).

Funds must be scheduled by mid-March and materials must be ordered by April 1, 2016. All materials must be delivered by June 30, 2016.

ELL Curriculum Specialists, Compliance and Performance Specialists from DELLSS will visit each school at least two times to support program implementation, evaluate program effectiveness and document best practices.

Each school will receive \$5,000, which are presented on the attached table. Allocations will be placed in each school's budget under the allocation category: **Title III TBE-DL Home Language Arts (CW)**
