SUBJECT: Guidance Counselors in High Need Schools

In FY 2016, the DOE will support high need schools by funding a guidance counselor to positively impact students' academic success, social emotional development, and post-secondary planning. This memorandum allocates funding for this initiative.

The following selection criteria were used to identify participating schools:

- Secondary schools serving grades 7-12 that during FY 2015 had neither a guidance counselor nor a school social worker;
- Focus, Priority, Persistently Dangerous or Potentially Persistently Dangerous, and/or Renewal schools that lacked a full-time guidance counselor (less than 1.0 FTE guidance counselor) in FY 2015; and
- Potentially Persistently Dangerous schools with a School Violence Transitional Index exceeding 3.0 that had 1.0 FTE guidance counselor in FY 2015.

The identified schools are receiving funding to support the hiring of one full-time guidance counselor or full-time bilingual guidance counselor who will be responsible for delivering a comprehensive program supporting all students to be effective learners and contributing members of the school community. The funding may only be used for an additional full-time guidance counselor position that a school lacked during FY 2015. The funding may not be used to support any other pedagogical or non-pedagogical positions.

School counselors work in collaboration with the entire school community and are committed to the education and whole development of all students. The school counselor is a key student and staff support services professional. Services provided by school counselors address the three domains of the American School Counselor Association (ASCA) model:

- Academic Planning
- Personal/Social Development

- Career and Post-Secondary Development

The position will be budgeted at the average guidance counselor salary in the allocation category **TL GUIDANCE SUPPORT HIGH NEED**.
