**SUBJECT:** Renewal Schools Teacher Leadership Allocation

This memorandum allocates funds to Renewal Schools to support Model Teachers, Peer Collaborative Teachers (PCTs), and Master Teachers. As part of the Renewal School program, the DOE is providing resources and supports to ensure effective school leadership and rigorous instruction with collaborative teachers. These positions aim to recruit and retain experienced and talented educators, create opportunities for collaboration across the school community, and further develop and refine teacher practice. Allocation amounts for each school can be viewed in the attached table.

Model Teachers are 100% in-classroom positions and model best practices while supporting the development of their colleagues through reflection and collaboration. PCTs support their colleagues through a variety of activities, including focused coaching and organizing inter-visitations. Master Teachers promote excellent teaching at the school- and district-level through the purposeful sharing of best practices, peer coaching, and creating a collaborative learning culture. PCTs and Master Teachers receive 20% release time to perform work related to their teacher leader role.

Model Teachers and PCTs receive \$7,500 and \$12,500, respectively, as a salary addition. Master Teachers receive \$20,000 as a salary addition. All salary additions are included in the teacher leader's semi-monthly paycheck over the course of SY 2015-2016.

This allocation provides up to \$27,500 for each Renewal School; please note that schools must have teachers who have been entered into the pool of qualified candidates and are staffed into these roles in order to receive funding. Principals have the discretion to determine which roles the funding will support. The funds for this allotment were placed in the "**Title I Renewal School Teacher Leadership**" allocation category.
