SUBJECT: Teacher Career Pathway Allocation – Subsidy Schools

With the establishment of new teacher career pathways in New York City, the NYCDOE and UFT agreed to convert the Lead Teacher position to better serve the needs of our schools. Schools that previously received subsidies for Lead Teacher(s) will continue to have the opportunity to receive funds to support teacher leaders. This memorandum allocates these subsidies. Allocation amounts for each school can be viewed in the attached table.

Funds will be used to support the staffing of the Model Teacher and/or Peer Collaborative Teacher (PCT) positions. These positions aim to recruit and retain experienced and talented educators, create opportunities for collaboration across the school community, and further develop and refine teacher practice.

Model Teachers are 100% in-classroom positions and model best practices while supporting the development of their colleagues through reflection and collaboration. PCTs support their colleagues through a variety of activities, including focused coaching and organizing inter-visitations. PCTs spend at least 20% of their teaching time each day facilitating the learning of peers. They must be released at least one period per day to perform their responsibilities as a PCT and may be released up to 60% of their teaching time each day, at the discretion of the school leader. Master Teachers support the development of their peers by creating professional learning opportunities, leading teacher teams, and facilitating coaching conversations with colleagues across school communities or within a school district. Master Teachers must be released at least one period per day to perform their responsibilities and teach a minimum program of the equivalent of one period per day.

This allocation provides up to \$20,500 for each Lead Teacher that was subsidized during the 2014-15 school year. These funds can be used for the Model Teacher salary addition or the PCT salary addition and the release time associated with the PCT role. The funds for this subsidy will be placed in the allocation category, "**TL Teacher Career Pathway – Subsidy Allocation.**"

Model Teachers receive \$7,500, PCTs receive \$12,500, and Master Teachers receive \$20,000 as a salary addition, which is included in the teacher leader's semi-monthly paycheck over the course of SY 2015-2016. Please note that schools must have teachers who have been entered into the pool of qualified candidates and are staffed into these roles in order to receive the allocation. Principals have the discretion to determine which roles the funding will support.
