SUBJECT: Arts for English Language Learners & Students with Disabilities

This memorandum allocates supplemental funding to schools to support school-based arts residencies that enhance arts instruction for diverse student learners, with a focus on students with disabilities and English Language Learners. The schools included in this allocation were selected through the 2015-2016 *Arts for English Language Learners and Students with Disabilities* grant program, administered by Office of Arts and Special Projects.

This memorandum details the funding that selected schools will receive in FY 2016, to be used to support the arts education projects/residencies detailed by schools in their grant applications. Funding may be used to pay for direct services from arts and cultural organizations (e.g. school-based arts residences, performances, curriculum development and planning, and production of project-related reports). In addition, each school will receive a small per session allocation to cover teacher hours for such activities as planning, meetings, and curriculum review.

Schools will be expected to cover all other associated project expenses (e.g. additional per session hours, supplies, materials, and project resources not provided by the arts education partners). Schools may not use funding to supplant previously allocated funds.

Individual school OTPS allocations will range up to \$15,000, varying based on the amount schools had requested in their grant applications. The Per Session allocation for each school is \$1,058, to be used for up to 24 hours of teacher per session. Schools will receive funding for this program under two discrete allocation categories:

- **“TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project OTPS”, “TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project OTPS HS” or “TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project OTPS CW”** – Allocation category can only be used to support OTPS costs of direct student services.
- **“TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project PS”, “TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project PS HS” or “TL ELL/Special Needs Partner Arts Project PS CW”** – Allocation category can be only be scheduled for teacher per session in Galaxy.

All standard operating procedures and fiscal year deadlines for procurement with tax-levy funds apply. Schools will be required to provide documentation of all expenditures made with this funding allocation as part of an end-of-year grantee report that will be submitted to the Office of Arts and

Special Projects. Timely submission of a complete report in June 2016 will influence decisions regarding future school allocations.
