SUBJECT: Extended School Year Special Class Programs

This memorandum funds extended school year special class programs. Committees on Special Education (CSEs) determine whether a student requires extended school year (ESY) special education services during the summer in order to prevent substantial regression. Substantial regression would be indicated by a student's inability to maintain developmental levels due to a loss of skill, set of skill competencies or knowledge during the months of July and August. Programs must operate for a minimum of 30 days and focus on the areas in which the student is expected to experience regression.

Funds are allocated to schools to support the following services:

- assistant principal (*as needed*).
- special education teachers
- paraprofessionals
- coverage
- permits
- books and materials
- related service providers (*as needed*)
- secretary (*as needed*), and
- educational software and equipment

Schools providing extended school year special class services will receive an allocation based on the number of students mandated in summer 2016 at an applied attendance factor of 60%.

Funds are allocated in the following allocation categories:

- **TL RS Student Summer Services**
- **ESY Student Summer Services RS**
