

ABSTRACT

Parent Skills Workshops use the techniques of educational drama to help parents improve communication with their children, mediate family conflicts, and help their children succeed academically and socially. Through role-play and discussion, parents learn to set clear behavioral expectations, monitor and supervise their children, reinforce pro-social behavior, and create opportunities for family involvement in their children's lives. By acquiring and using these skills, parents can play a critical role in their children's development of resiliency skills.
