The Summer Arts Institute 2009

(SAI) is an intensive arts program offering participants an opportunity to study dance, theater, vocal music, instrumental music, visual art, film, or photography in a supportive and professional environment. Middle and high school students from New York City Department of Education public schools participate in this program at no charge. Admission into the program is selective, based on student auditions, interviews or portfolio presentations.

The Summer Arts Institute began in 2002 as a program of the Manhattan Superintendent's Office in response to the events of September 11, 2001. Since the summer of 2004, the New York City Department of Education's Office of the Arts and Special Projects has guided the direction of SAI, which is an invaluable resource for public school students interested in pursuing their studies in the arts.



SAI works with students to develop artistic skills, to broaden awareness of the arts, and to recognize and explore career options in the arts and arts-related industries. Students create portfolios and develop performance pieces to support their applications for advanced study at the high school, college, or conservatory level. Field trips to city theaters, galleries and concert halls complement the studio experience. During the course of the Institute, students also have opportunities to perform at various venues across the city.

Each studio is staffed by a master New York City Department of Education arts teacher and, in many cases, a teaching artist from a New York City arts organization. This year's arts partners include American Ballet Theatre, Tribeca Film Institute, Theatre for a New Audience, and Young Audiences New York. Teachers and teaching artists work to co-plan curriculum, critique student work and provide SAI participants with feedback on their progress.



The Summer Arts Institute is grounded in *The Blueprint for Teaching and Learning in the Arts* in that it connects students to community and cultural resources along with providing access to careers and lifelong learning in the arts. Every summer SAI culminates with an exhibition of student art and photography and a live performance featuring all of SAI's young musicians, dancers, actors and filmmakers.
