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Description: Teachers of dance, music, theater, and visual arts will engage in an experiential cycle of exploration, reflection, planning, adaptation, and implementation of individualized pedagogical practices. This cycle of improvement aims to equip arts teachers to use highly effective practices in their classrooms to support rigorous arts-making experiences for all learners that is sequential, of high-quality, and is culturally responsive. Teachers of the arts will meet their professional learning goals by participating in a three-day blended learning series that is arts-specific and borough-based. Throughout the Teacher Effectiveness in the Arts workshop series, arts teachers will have an opportunity to engage in on-going in-person and virtual conversations rooted in the Blueprint for Teaching and Learning in the Arts, the Specific Considerations, and the Danielson Framework for Teaching.

This series is separate from but aligns with the Citywide PD Sessions and the Arts Monday Support.
