Registration Checklist

- Proof of your child's age (child's birth certificate, passport, or record of baptism),
- ☐ Your child's immunization records (if available),
- ☐ Your child's latest report card/ transcript (if available), and
- ☐ Two (2) documents verifying proof of address find examples of accepted documents at on.nyc.gov/NewStudents.

*PLEASE NOTE: Students in Temporary Housing, as defined by McKinney-Vento, are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization) to enroll. Schools must provisionally pre-register the student and then work with the students in temporary housing NYCPS contact to obtain documentation.
